# Role of the Governance Group

- Facilitate implementation
- Provide advice to Minister responsible for Whānau Ora
- Provide leadership to government agencies and stakeholders
- Provide leadership and direction at a national and regional level on Whānau Ora



# Regional Leadership Groups

- 10 Regional Leadership Groups
- TPK, MSD, DHB officials and community representatives appointed by Minister
- Role:
  - provide advice and recommendations to Governance Group
  - lead strategic change for Whānau Ora in region
  - foster communications and relationships

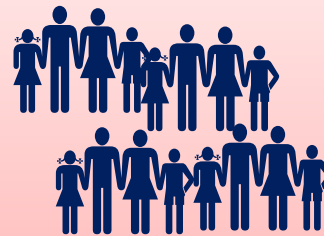

# Whānau Initiative

- Investment in whānau engagement and leadership
- Funding via TPK
- Funding proposals invited from August 2010



# Whānau Centred Services

- Nationwide EOI process – commence early June
- Up to 20 providers or provider groupings in first year
- Governance Group selection against specific criteria
- Integration of contracts
- Provision for training & development
